


B-Raf (V600R)

Background: B-Raf is a member of the Raf family of Ser/Thr protein kinases. It functions downstream of Ras to regulate the MAP kinase signaling pathway. Mutations in the BRAF gene cause diseases. Inherited mutations in BRAF cause cardiofaciocutaneous syndrome. Acquired mutations in BRAF have been found in cancers. Immunogen: A synthetic peptide from the internal region of B-Raf (V600R), human origin. Tested applications: ELISA, WB, IHC **Recommended dilutions:** 1:1000-1:5000 ELISA WB 1:500-1:1500 IHC 1:100-1:200 Concentration: 0.9 mg/ml Host: Mouse **Clonality:** Monoclonal Isotype: Unknown Purity: Purified from ascites Format: Liquid Storage buffer: Preservative: no **Constituents**: PBS (without Mg²⁺ and Ca²⁺), pH 7.4, 150 mM NaCl, 50% glycerol Species Reactivity: Recognizes V600R mutated, but not wild-type B-Raf proteins. Storage Conditions: Store at -20°C. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles.

Western blot analysis of recombinant B-raf proteins. Purified His-tagged B-Raf (V600R) protein (lane 2) and corresponding wild type protein (lane 1) were blotted with anti-B-Raf (V600R) monoclonal antibody (Cat. # 26182).

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
